

PFA Paddleball Players Rating Level Criteria

All,

As most of you know there is no measurable criteria to rate Paddleball players as "A" or "B" level. Each tournament director have their own formula for rating players. This is a very difficult task because there is no measurable criteria to determine who is an "A" or "B" player. We, Paddleball Family Alliance, have 'DRAFTED' a criteria we feel is measurable. We are planning to use this criteria for our upcoming "B" tournament May 15, 2016 at Central Park.

PLEASE review the criteria and do not hesitate to send us your suggestions/feedback. If you rather inbox me separately go ahead. We will carefully review all suggestions/feedback and incorporate them if the majority agree it makes the criteria easier to measure. We hope that by the end of this process we collectively come up with a criteria that is satisfactory to the majority of the paddleball community.

Players that meets one of the criteria below will be rated an "A" player:

1. Won an Open tournament.
2. Won a "B" & Semifinalists in an Open tournament.
3. Won 2 Bs tournament.
4. Won one "B" and finalist in 2 other "B".
5. Semifinalists in 2 open tournaments
6. Finalists in 3 "B" tournaments.
7. Once an "A" player, always an "A" player.
8. Players are individually rated, not as a team.
9. Tournaments MUST be rated.
10. Out-of-Hat tournament are not part of the criteria. Partners and competition makes it difficult to rate. It does not follow a measurable criteria.
11. Invitational tournaments are not part of the criteria - These events are handpicked and do not allow all players to compete.
